STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHIY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes of 1883, relating to the rights of married women.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 61 of the Re-2 vised Statutes of 1883 is hereby amended by 3 striking out, in the fourth line of said section, 4 after the word "directly," the words "or in-5 directly," and by striking out in the fifth and sixth 6 lines of said section the words, "or paid for by 7 him, or given or devised to her by his relatives," 8 so that said section, as amended, shall read as 9 follows:

SENATE-No. 14.

'A married woman, of any age, may own in her 11 own right real and personal estate acquired by 12 descent, gift, or purchase; and may manage, sell, 13 convey, and devize the same by will, without the 14 joinder or assent of her husband; but, real estate 15 directly conveyed to her by her husband cannot be 16 conveyed by her without the joinder of her hus-17 band, except real estate conveyed to her as security 18 or in payment of a *bona fide* debt actually due to 19 her from her husband. When payment was made 20 for property conveyed to her from the property of 21 her husband, or it was conveyed by him to her 22 without a valuable consideration, it may be taken 23 as the property of her husband to pay his debts 24 cont. acted before such purchase.'
