### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act creating certain Islands in the town of Cumberland into a Voting District, 'approved February 23, 1887.'"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The fourth section of said act is hereby amended 2 by adding thereto the following:

'The list for said island district shall be posted in

- 4 some public and conspicuous place in said district.
- 5 In addition to the sessions now required by law,
- 6 the selectmen shall be in open session on the two
- 7 secular days next preceding any election to which

8 this act applies, for the purpose of receiving appli9 cations of residents in said island district claiming
10 a right to vote therein; and notice of the time and
11 place of such sessions shall be given in the warrant
12 for calling the meeting in said district; and at such
13 sessions the selectmen shall be governed by the
14 provisions of chapter four of the Revised Statutes
15 so far as applicable,' so that said section as amended
16 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. The assessors and selectmen shall pre-18 pare separate lists of qualified voters for said island 19 district and the remainder of the town, and all 20 provisions of law relating to the preparation and 21 posting of such lists in towns, apply to both lists 22 herein provided for, except that no changes shall 23 be made in the list for the island district on the day 24 of election. The list for said island district shall 25 be posted in some public and conspicuous place in 26 said district. In addition to the sessions now 27 required by law, the selectmen shall be in open 28 session on the two secular days next preceding any 29 election to which this act applies, for the purpose 30 of receiving applications of residents in said island 31 district claiming a right to vote therein; notice of 32 the time and place of such sessions shall be given

- 33 in the warrant for calling the meeting in said dis-
- 34 trict; and as such sessions the selectmen shall be
- 35 governed by the provisions of chapter four of the
- 36 Revised Statutes, so far as applicable.'
