IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

---

AN ACT to authorize Fred C. Barker to navigate  
Mooselucmegantic and Cupsuptic lakes, in Franklin  
and Oxford counties, by steam.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Fred C. Barker, his associates and  
2 assigns, are hereby authorized and vested with the  
3 exclusive right, against all persons, of employing  
4 and navigating every kind of boat or water craft  
5 propelled by steam, as common carriers, on all the  
6 waters of the Mooselucmegantic and Cupsuptic  
7 lakes and intervening waters, in Franklin and  
8 Oxford counties, that lie south of a line drawn due  
9 east and west across said waters at Haines'  
10 Landing, so called, for the term of six years.

SECT. 9. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
