STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section forty-seven of chapter ninety-one of the Revised Statutes, relating to liens or pledges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section forty-seven of chapter ninety-
2 one of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
3 adding after the words "whoever has a lien on" the
4 words 'or pledge of' so that said section as amended
5 shall read as follows: 'Whoever has a lien on or
6 pledge of any stock or certificate thereof, bond, note,
7 account, or other chose in action, or on any personal
8 property in his possession, may enforce it by sale
9 thereof, as hereinafter provided.'
