STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Winterport Savings Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. R. G. Campbell, A. E. Fernald, D. H. 2 Smith, John W. Carleton, C. R. Hill, Amos H. Hall, 3 E. C. Arey, Daniel Dyer, John M. Snow, E. R. Grant, 4 Fred Atwood, A. R. Fellows, Percy C. Rich, John 5 Stokel, George Peirce, their associates and successors, 6 are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by 7 the name of the Winterport Savings Bank, with all the 8 rights and privileges, and subject to all the liabilities and 9 duties incident to similar institutions by the laws of this 10 State, with full power by that name to prosecute and de- 11 fend suits at law and in equity; to have and to use a com- 12 mon seal; to elect such officers as are required by the 13 laws of this State, with full power by that name to 14 prosecute and defend suits at law and in equity; to have

15 and to use a common seal; to elect such officers as are
16 required by the laws of this State, and others that may be
17 necessary for the transaction of business; to make,
18 establish, and enforce by-laws for the management of the
19 concerns of the corporation not repugnant to the laws
20 of this State. Said bank shall be established at Winterport.

SECT. 2. The first meeting of said corporation may be
2 held at such time and place as the first five incorporators
3 may designate, by giving notice thereof seven days previ-
4 ously, in any newspaper published in Waldo county. At
5 said meeting, and every subsequent annual meeting, new
6 members may be elected by ballot. It shall require at
7 least seven of the incorporators, or their associates, to con-
8 stitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

SECT. 3. All deeds of conveyance or other instru-
2 ments made in behalf of the corporation, shall be sealed
3 with the corporate seal, and when made in pursuance of
4 any vote of the corporation, shall be valid to convey prop-
5 erty or bind the corporation.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
