STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the New Sharon Water Power
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. Z. A. Dyer, Thomas B. Ridley, Nathaniel
2 Harding, W. W. Norcross, Simon Greenleaf, Daniel L.
3 Swan, E. W. Young, George H. Brown, of New Sharon,
4 Frank A. Morrill of Somerville, Massachusetts, their
5 associates, successors, and assigns, are hereby created a
6 corporation, by the name of the New Sharon Water
7 Power Company, with all the rights and powers, and
8 subject to all the duties and liabilities of similar corpora-
9 tions, organized under the general laws of this State.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to own,
2 construct and maintain a dam or dams, side-dams, flumes
3 and canal on the Sandy river in New Sharon, for the
4 purpose of holding, storing, discharging and regulating

5 the flow of water, for the benefit of the water powers and
6 privileges, now on said waters, and to sell, lease or rent,
7 surplus water, to the same or others; and to hold and
8 possess certain rights and privileges, that may be granted
9 said corporation by the mill owners.

SECT. 3. The first meeting of the corporators for
2 organization, may be called on written notices signed by
3 any two of them, three days, at least, before the meeting,
4 naming the time, place and purpose of such meeting.

SECT. 4. The amount of the capital stock may be fixed
2 by the corporation, at first, at such sum as they think will
3 be required for the purpose herein specified, and may
4 afterwards by vote of not less than three-fourths of all
5 the stock, be increased from time to time, if necessary,
6 at any regular meeting of the stockholders, not to exceed
7 twenty-five thousand dollars in all.

SECT. 5. Said corporation shall be authorized to pur-
2 chase, hold and convey real estate and personal property
3 sufficient to carry out the purposes of this corporation as
4 herein stated.

SECT. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
