STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT restraining the sale of tobacco and use of
same by minors under sixteen years of age.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall sell any cigarette,
2 snuff or tobacco in any form to any person under
3 the age of sixteen years.

SECT. 2. No person, other than the minor's
2 parent or guardian, shall give to any person under
3 the age of sixteen years any cigarette, snuff or
4 tobacco in any form, for such minor's personal use.

SECT. 3. Any person violating any of the fore-
2 going provisions shall be punished by a fine not
3 exceeding fifty dollars.

SECT. 4. Any minor under the age of sixteen
2 years who shall smoke any cigarette or tobacco in
3 any form in any street, alley, way, park, school
4 yard, public conveyance, place of amusement, or
5 other place of resort, shall be punished for the
6 first offence by a fine not exceeding five dollars,
7 and for the second or subsequent offence by a fine
8 not exceeding ten dollars.
