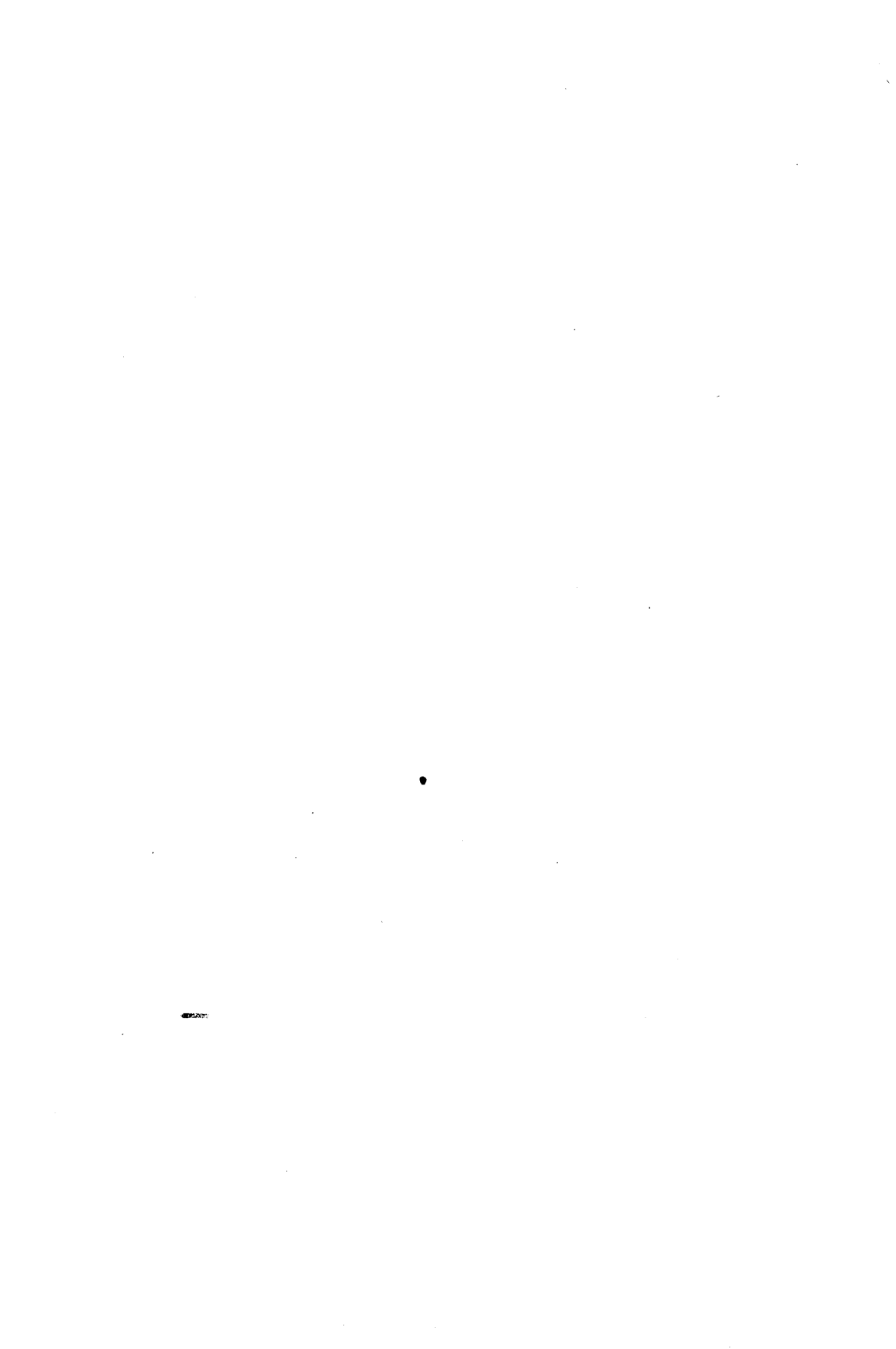
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Temporary Home for
Women and Children.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars
2 be, and hereby is appropriated for the use of the
3 Temporary Home for Women and Children at
4 Deering, of which five hundred dollars shall be paid
5 during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine,
6 and five hundred dollars during the year eighteen
7 hundred and ninety.
