STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for repair of roads in Indian Township, Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and 2 twenty-five dollars be and hereby is appropriated 3 for the year 1889, and the sum of two hundred and 4 twenty-five dollars for the year 1890, and also an 5 additional sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to be 6 expended in the purchase of a road machine in the 7 year 1889. All of which sums so appropriated 8 are to be expended under the direction of the 9 Governor and Council, upon the Houlton and Bar- 10 ing road and the road leading from said Houlton 11 and Baring road to Grand Lake stream in Indian 12 township in Washington county.
