IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 17 of chapter 3 of the
Revised Statutes, relating to Deputy Town Clerks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 3 of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following words: 'He may also appoint a woman,
4 otherwise qualified by the Constitution, who in his
5 absence may so far act as deputy clerk as to receive
6 and record chattel mortgages and other papers and
7 make certified copies of the records in the clerk's
8 office.'
