STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the removal of the Maine
State Prison.

Resolved, That the Governor and Council be and
2 hereby are authorized to appoint three commission-
3 ers to inquire into the expediency of the removal
4 of the Maine State Prison to some other place than
5 that in which it is now situated, and to investigate
6 and recommend in regard to a proper place there-
7 for, the buildings and arrangements necessary to
8 carry out such removal, and the probable cost of
9 the same, and report to the Governor and Council
10 for the information of the next legislature. The
11 sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars is hereby
12 appropriated to pay the expenses and services of
13 such commissioners, to be paid by the State treas-
14 urer on warrants of the Governor and Council.
