STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 15 of chapter 140 of the Revised Statutes, relating to deduction from convicts' sentences for good conduct.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1, Section 15 of chapter 140 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

‘SECT. 15. He shall keep a record of the conduct of each convict, and for every month during which it thereby appears that such convict has faithfully observed all the rules and requirements of the prison, the warden may recommend to the executive a deduction of seven days from the term of said convict's sentence, except those sentenced to imprisonment for life.

Provided, however, that this act shall not be construed as lessening the deduction to which any convict under sentence when it takes effect would otherwise be entitled.’
