STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the purchase of certain volumes of
Maine Reports.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be and he hereby
1 is authorized and directed to purchase of Mosher, Mc-
2 Lellan & Company fifty copies of each of the following
3 volumes of the Maine Reports, now out of print, but in
4 process of re-publication by said firm, at a price not
5 exceeding four dollars per volume, to wit: volumes
6 ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13) and
7 fourteen (14), provided that said Mosher, McLellan &
8 Company shall furnish to the State Library the following
9 volumes of Maine Reports, in which the library is now
10 deficient, and take in exchange and payment therefor,
11 volume for volume, other volumes of the Maine Reports
12 of which the State Library now has a surplus. The list
13 of reports so to be furnished in exchange is as follows :

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The volumes of Maine Reports covered by this resolve are now out of print, and their republication was commenced two years ago by the former publishers of the Reports. It has been the custom of the State to aid the republication of the Reports, so that the series may be kept complete in the market. The State Library has a surplus of certain volumes of the Reports and a deficiency of others. If this purchase is made the publishers agree to furnish by even exchange such volumes as are needed in the State Library for distribution.
