STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 77, section 6, clause X. of the Revised Statutes, relating to equity jurisdiction of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 77, section 6, clause X. of 2 the Revised Statutes is amended by striking out 3 the words, "found within the State," so that the 4 clause shall read as follows:

'X.—In suits for re-delivery of goods or chattels 6 taken or detained from the owner and secreted or 7 withheld, so that the same cannot be replevied, 8 and in bills in equity, by creditors, to reach and 9 apply in payment of a debt, any property, right,

10 title or interest, legal or equitable, of a debtor or
11 debtors, which cannot be come at to be attached
12 on writ, or taken on execution in a suit at law, and
13 not exempt from such attachment and seizure, and
14 any property or interest conveyed in fraud of
15 creditors.'
