STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of
Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

Resolved, That the sum of thirty thousand dol-
2 lars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf
3 of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the
4 Mechanic Arts for the years eighteen hundred and
5 eighty-nine and eighteen hundred and ninety to be
6 expended as follows: amount to be used in cancel-
7 ling the indebtedness arising from the destruction
8 of the herd in 1886, six thousand dollars, for com-
9 pleting the experiment station building, four hun-
10 dred dollars, re-stocking the farm, fifteen hundred
11 dollars, for Coburn hall, including cases, tables,
12 etc., additional cases in the library and chairs and
13 fittings for audience-room, twenty-nine hundred

14 and fifty dollars, for gas fixtures and a supply of
15 gas for two years, four hundred dollars, library,
16 including periodicals, books and binding, one thou-
17 sand dollars, apparatus for the several departments,
18 two thousand nine hundred dollars, military depart-
19 ment, one hundred dollars, forges, drawing tables
20 and sheathing drawing-room in shop, three hundred
21 dollars, water supply and drainage for shop, two
22 hundred dollars, drawing tables in civil engineering
23 department, two hundred dollars, steam heating
24 apparatus for chemical laboratory, three hundred
25 dollars, repairs on buildings, fifteen hundred dol-
26 lars, construction of road near experiment station
27 and gravel for walks, five hundred dollars, raising
28 ell of chemical laboratory building one story and
29 fitting up room for blowpipe analysis, one thou-
30 sand dollars, traveling expenses of trustees, five
31 hundred dollars, insurance of buildings, two hun-
32 dred and fifty dollars, lathes and planers for iron
33 working, four thousand dollars, foundry, one thou-
34 sand dollars, construction of greenhouse and
35 appliances for department of horticulture, two
36 thousand dollars, steam-pump main and distributing
37 pipes for supplying all departments of the college
38 with soft water from the Stillwater river, three

39 thousand dollars, and of the sum hereby appropri-
40 ated for the purposes above named, twenty thou-
41 sand dollars shall be payable during the year one
42 thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine and ten
43 thousand dollars during the year one thousand
44 eight hundred and ninety.
