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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter 204 Public  
Laws of 1856, as amended by section one of chapter  
57, Public Laws of 1859, to change the return day  
of civil actions in the Municipal Court for the city of  
Portland, from Monday to Tuesday of each week.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter 204, Public  
2 Laws of 1856, as amended by section one of chapter  
3 57 Public Laws of 1859, is hereby amended so as  
4 to read:

'SECT. 9. The municipal court shall be held every  
6 day at nine o'clock in the forenoon, Sundays and  
7 days on which no courts can be held excepted; all

8 civil processes shall be returnable on Tuesday of  
9 each week and at no other time. Provided that no  
10 civil process begun prior to January 1, A. D. 1890,  
11 made returnable on a Monday, the present civil  
12 day but otherwise in legal form and legally served  
13 shall be abated, but said action may be entered in  
14 said court on the following Tuesday and the same  
15 proceedings then had as though originally made  
16 returnable on that day.'
