STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT regulating the taking of smelts in the
Sheepscot river, between Wiscasset toll bridge and
head of the tide, in Alna.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for smelts in
2 the Sheepscot river or its tributaries, between
3 Wiscasset toll bridge and the head of the tide, in
4 Alna, except by hook and line, or by dip net.

SECT. 2. The penalty for violating section 1 of
2 this act shall be not less than five dollars or more
3 than fifty dollars for each offence, to be recovered
4 by indictment, or action of debt, before any court
5 having jurisdiction.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
