STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to regulate the alewife fishery in Pemaquid
River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited
2 from fishing with nets, seines, traps and wiers in
3 that part of Pemaquid river which lies between
4 Pemaquid falls, and a line drawn west from the old
5 Pemaquid fort for a term of six years from the pas-
6 sage of this act.

SECT. 2. All fishing for alewives at or about
2 Pemaquid falls shall be restricted to four days in
3 each week, and the fishing season shall be from the
4 first day of May to the fifteenth day of July in each
5 year and all fishing shall be confined to the falls,

6 and under such regulation and further restriction as
7 the town of Bristol shall decide upon.

SECT. 3. Any person violating any of the pro-
2 visions of this act shall be subjected to a fine of
3 twenty dollars recoverable before any court having
4 jurisdiction.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
