STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 67, Section 38, Revised Statutes, relating to adoption of Children.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirty-eight, chapter sixty-seven of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "inhabitants of his county" and
4 inserting in the place thereof the word 'persons,'
5 so that said section as amended shall read as
6 follows:

'SECT. 38. Any judge of probate may, on petition
8 of two or more persons, after notice and hearing,
9 and for good cause shown, reverse and annul any
10 decree of the probate court in his county, whereby
11 any child has been adopted under this chapter.'
