STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize George R. Gleason and his associates and assigns to Dredge and Navigate by Steam, Great Pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. George R. Gleason, his associates
2 and assigns are hereby authorized to clear chan-
3 nels, dredge bars and remove stones in Great pond
4 in the counties of Kennebec and Somerset, and are
5 hereby vested with the exclusive right, against all
6 persons, of employing and navigating every kind
7 of boat or water craft, propelled by steam, for
8 carrying passengers on said Great pond, for the
9 term of ten years from the passage of this act.

SECT. 2. If the persons named in this act, their
2 associates or assigns, shall, for the term of two
3 years after the passage of this act, fail to navigate
4 said water by steam, then this act shall be void.
