STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of
Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

Resolved, That the sum of thirty thousand dollars
2 be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the
3 Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic
4 Arts for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-nine
5 and eighteen hundred and ninety to be expended as
6 follows: Amount to be used in canceling the indebt-
7 edness arising from the destruction of the herd in
8 1886, six thousand dollars; for completing the exper-
9 iment station building, four hundred dollars; re-
10 stocking the farm, fifteen hundred dollars; for
11 Coburn hall, including cases, tables, etc., additional
12 cases in the library and chairs and fittings for audi-

13 ence-room, twenty-nine hundred and fifty dollars;
14 for gas fixtures and a supply of gas for two years,
15 four hundred dollars; library, including periodicals,
16 books and binding, one thousand dollars; apparatus
17 for the several departments, two thousand nine
18 hundred dollars; military department, one hundred
19 dollars; forges, drawing-tables and sheathing draw-
20 ing-room in shop, three hundred dollars; water
21 supply and drainage for shop, two hundred dollars;
22 drawing-tables in civil engineering department,
23 two hundred dollars; steam heating apparatus for
24 chemical laboratory, three hundred dollars; repairs
25 on buildings, fifteen hundred dollars; construction
26 of road near experiment station and gravel for
27 walks, five hundred dollars; raising ell of chemical
28 laboratory building one story and fitting up room for
29 blow-pipe analysis, one thousand dollars; traveling
30 expenses of trustees, five hundred dollars; insur-
31 ance of buildings, two hundred and fifty dollars;
32 lathes and planers for iron working, four thousand
33 dollars; foundry, one thousand dollars; construc-
34 tion of greenhouse and appliances for department
35 of horticulture, two thousand dollars; steam-pump,
36 main and distributing pipes for supplying all
37 departments of the college with soft water from

38 the Stillwater river, three thousand dollars; and of
39 the sum hereby appropriated for the purposes
40 above named, twenty thousand dollars shall be
41 payable during the year one thousand eight hun-
42 dred and eighty-nine and ten thousand dollars
43 during the year one thousand eight hundred and
44 ninety. *Provided, however,* that each of the several
45 sums hereinbefore mentioned shall be used for the
46 respective purposes specified in this resolve and
47 for no other; that the trustees of said college shall
48 contract no debt for any purpose whatever; and
49 that they shall in their annual reports hereafter
50 submitted to the Governor and Council, render a
51 separate account in detail, of the receipts from all
52 sources and expenditures for every purpose what-
53 soever in the several departments, together with
54 the loss or gain in such department.
