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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to define Robbery and its Punishment.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section sixteen of chapter one hun-  
2 dred and eighteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby  
3 amended, so that the same shall read as follows:

'SECT. 16. Whoever, by force and violence, or by  
5 putting in fear, feloniously steals and takes from  
6 the person of another, property that is the subject  
7 of larceny is guilty of robbery and shall be pun-  
8 ished by imprisonment for life or for any term of  
9 years.'
