STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Lincoln Village
Corporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 146 of Private
2 and Special Laws of Maine, approved February
3 24th, 1887, is hereby amended so as to read as
4 follows:

'SECT. 1. The territory in the town of Lincoln,
6 in the county of Penobscot, together with the
7 inhabitants thereof, included within the following
8 boundaries, namely: Beginning on the easterly
9 bank of the Penobscot river, at the southwesterly
10 line of the homestead farm of the late David Bailey
11 and in that part of said Lincoln formerly dominated

12 'River Township, No. three'; thence southeast-
13 erly on said line to the Lee road, and thence in the
14 same direction to the northwesterly line of the
15 'Loring Tract' so called; thence southwesterly on
16 said Loring line to the Mattanawcook pond; thence
17 southwesterly to a point where the southeasterly
18 line of the homestead of Dorcas Bruce strikes said
19 pond; thence southwesterly on last mentioned line
20 to the southerly corner of said Bruce homestead;
21 thence northwesterly on southwesterly line of said
22 Bruce homestead to the easterly corner of the
23 homestead of Wm. C. Warren; thence south-
24 westerly on southeasterly line of said Warren
25 homestead to its southerly corner at the Heald
26 road; thence northwesterly on said Heald road to
27 the Enfield back road, so called; thence on said
28 Enfield back road, northwesterly to the southerly
29 corner of F. E. Nute's homestead; thence north-
30 westerly on the southwesterly line of said Nute
31 homestead to its westerly corner and to the south-
32 easterly line of land of C. L. Pickering; thence
33 southwesterly on line of said Pickering's land to
34 the southerly corner of the same; thence north-
35 westerly on the southwesterly line of said Picker-
36 ing's land to the Military road; thence by said last
37 named road to the southwesterly corner of the

33 Lincoln village graveyard; thence northerly on the
39 westerly line of said graveyard and land of C. H.
40 Miller and on southwesterly line of the homestead
41 farm of E. T. Fuller to the Penobscot river, and
42 thence northerly by said river to the southwesterly
43 line of the aforesaid Bailey homestead and the
44 point begun at, be and the same are hereby made
45 a body politic and corporate by the name of the
46 Lincoln Village Corporation.'

SECT. 2. This act shall be effectual to take out
2 the people, property and territory included in the
3 act incorporating the Lincoln Village Corporation'
4 approved February 24th, 1887, and excluded by this
5 act of amendment, whenever two-thirds of the legal
6 voters within the territory included by said act
7 approved February 24th, 1887, shall, at a legal
8 meeting of said corporation, by ballot, vote to
9 accept this amendment. But this act shall not
10 authorize said corporation to do any business after
11 its territory shall have been reduced as herein
12 provided, unless two-thirds of the legal voters
13 within its territorial limits as fixed and defined by
14 this act, shall, at a legal meeting, by ballot, vote to
15 accept this amendment.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
