STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter two hundred and fifty-nine (259) of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, relating to the May term of the Supreme Judicial Court of Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred
2 and fifty-nine of the Public Laws of eighteen hun-
3 dred and eighty-five is hereby amended by striking
4 out the words "either" and "or" in the ninth line
5 thereof and the word "traverse" in the tenth line
6 thereof, and by inserting after the word "jury" in
7 the tenth line, the words, 'and with only one

8 traverse jury in attendance,' so that said section as
9 amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 1. After the first day of April in the
11 present year, the supreme judicial court, within
12 and for the county of Oxford, shall be holden at
13 Paris in said county, on the second Tuesday of
14 October and on the second Tuesday of February,
15 annually, instead of at the times as now provided
16 by law, and in addition to the above named terms,
17 the same court shall be held annually, hereafter, by
18 one of the justices thereof, at said Paris, on the
19 first Tuesday of May, which last named term shall
20 be held without grand jury, and with only one
21 traverse jury in attendance, unless otherwise
22 specially ordered by any judge of said court. All
23 recognizances and other criminal processes, made
24 returnable to, and to have day in said May term,
25 when no criminal business is transacted, shall be
26 continued to, and have day in the next term of said
27 court, held in said county.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
