STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Plantation of Carrying
Place.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and fifty-
2 one dollars and sixty-one cents be and is hereby
3 appropriated from the State school fund and the same
4 to be paid to the plantation of Carrying Place, the
5 same being said plantation's proportion of said
6 fund and forty-one dollars and fifty-five cents of
7 the same to be taken from the State school fund of
8 the current year.
