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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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### AN ACT to equalize school privileges in towns.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 11 of the  
2 Revised Statutes, together with so much of section  
3 15 of the same chapter as relates to the apportion-  
4 ment of school money to districts is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. All school moneys raised by towns or  
2 apportioned to towns from the State treasury for  
3 common school purposes, shall be expended solely  
4 by the superintending school committees of the  
5 several towns in such manner as to give, as nearly  
6 as practicable, schools of the same length in all  
7 districts.

SECT. 3. All laws and parts of laws inconsistent  
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall be in effect on and after  
2 the first day of April, A. D. 1889.
