## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

---

AN ACT to amend sections 29 and 41 of chapter 40,  
Revised Statutes, relating to Inland Fisheries.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 29 of chapter 40 of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking  
3 out the word "salmon" at the end of the third line;  
4 also by striking out all between "waters" in the fifth  
5 line and the "comma" in the eight line and insert-  
6 ing in place thereof the following words 'or in the  
7 Schoodic Lakes and their tributaries, or to the  
8 taking of white fish in the Schoodic Lakes and their  
9 tributaries during the months of May and Novem-  
10 ber,' so that said section as amended shall  
11 read as follows:

'SECT. 29. The following sections apply to all  
13 fresh waters above the flow of the tide and to all  
14 tidal waters frequented by the various species of  
15 fresh water and migratory fishes, except the capture  
16 of shad and alewives in Dennys river and its tribu-  
17 taries, and Pimmaquan river and its tributaries, or  
18 in the Schoodic Lakes and their tributaries, or to  
19 the taking of white fish in the Schoodic Lakes and  
20 their tributaries during the months of May and  
21 November, and except as provided in the two fol-  
22 lowing sections.'

SECT. 2. Section 41 of said chapter is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word "mill race"  
3 in the ninth line the words 'Provided that fly-fishing  
4 shall be allowed up to the bridge across Dennys  
5 river at Lincoln's Mills, but not between the said  
6 bridge and Lincoln's mill-dam,' so that said section  
7 as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 41. No salmon, shad, or other migratory,  
9 fish shall be taken or fished for within five hundred  
10 yards of any fish-way, dam or mill-race; nor  
11 between the Bangor and Brewer bridge over the  
12 Penobscot river and the water works dam at  
13 Treat's Falls, on said river; nor between the  
14 Augusta highway bridge over the Kennebec river  
15 and the Augusta dam, between the first days of

16 April and November, except by the ordinary mode  
17 of angling with a single hook and line or artificial  
18 flies, nor shall hook and line or artificial flies be  
19 used any time within one hundred yards of any  
20 fish-way, dam or mill-race. Provided that fly-fish-  
21 ing shall be allowed up to the bridge across Dennys  
22 river at Lincoln's Mills but not between the said  
23 bridge and Lincoln's mill-dam. The penalty for  
24 violation of this section is a fine of not more than  
25 fifty nor less than ten dollars for each offence, and  
26 a further fine of ten dollars for each salmon, and  
27 one dollar for each shad, so taken.'
