## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State Reform School.

---

*Resolved,* That the governor and council are  
2 hereby authorized if they they think it may be for  
3 the interest of the State, to purchase the Coleman  
4 farm, so called, consisting of twenty acres with  
5 buildings thereon, adjoining the State Reform  
6 School, for the use and benefit of said school, at  
7 a price not exceeding two thousand nine hundred  
8 dollars, and the sum aforesaid is hereby appropri-  
9 ated.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This estate adjoins the Reform School farm on the south, ascending from the school buildings for about twenty rods to the height of land, thence gradually descending, forming a most desirable location for the erection of the proposed new cottage, and it is better adapted to early gardening than any part of the present farm, which is most excellent grass land.
