STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for permanent encampments of the
Militia and for the Veterans of the late war.

Resolved, That thirty-five hundred dollars be
2 appropriated to be expended by the Governor for the
3 purchase of suitable grounds for permanent encamp-
4 ments of the Militia and for the use of the Veterans
5 of the late war, under such regulations as may be
6 established by the Governor.
