STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter eighteen
of the Revised Statutes, relating to Ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter eighteen of
2 the Revised Statutes is amended by striking out
3 the words "and that an inquiry into the merits is
4 expedient," so that said section as amended shall
5 read as follows:

'SECT. 2. Being satisfied that the petitioners are
7 responsible, they shall cause thirty days' notice to
8 be given of the time and place of their meeting by
9 posting copies of the petition, with their order
10 thereon, in three public places in each town in

11 which any part of the way is, and serving one on
12 the clerks of such towns, and publishing it in some
13 newspaper, if any, in the county. The fact that
14 notice has been so given, being proved and entered
15 of record, shall be sufficient for all interested, and
16 evidence thereof.'
