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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to hold the June term and a November term of the  
Superior Court, Kennebec County, in the City of Water-  
ville.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The June term of the superior court which  
2 is now required to be holden at Augusta, in and for the  
3 county of Kennebec, shall hereafter be holden in the city of  
4 Waterville, in said county; and a term of said court shall  
5 also be holden at said Waterville, in and for said county,  
6 for the transaction of civil business, on the second Tuesday  
7 of November in each year.

SECT. 2. The previous section of this act shall be void  
2 and of no effect, unless the city of Waterville aforesaid,  
3 shall on or before the first day of May, in the present  
4 year, without expense to said county of Kennebec, pro-

5 vide a suitable court room and other accommodations for  
6 said court and officers, to the acceptance of a majority of  
7 the county commissioners of the county of Kennebec, and  
8 shall execute and deliver to said commissioners a suffi-  
9 cient lease or other instrument to secure the use thereof  
10 to said county, for the purposes aforesaid, during the  
11 time in which said court is held in said city of Water-  
12 ville.

SECT. 3. The county commissioners of said county shall  
2 forthwith, after rooms for the accommodation of the court  
3 and officers as specified in this act have been provided,  
4 cause notice of the fact that suitable rooms have been pro-  
5 vided as herein specified, by publication in the daily issue  
6 of the Kennebec Journal, for at least thirty days prior to  
7 the second Tuesday of June, next after this act is approved.

SECT. 4. The judge of said court may continue any case  
2 pending in said court without costs when in his judgment  
3 justice may require it, in order to give the parties in inter-  
4 est opportunity to try any such case in either said Water-  
5 ville or Augusta in said county.

SECT. 5. The said city of Waterville is hereby author-  
2 ized and empowered to provide a building and furnish  
3 suitable accommodations, for holding the superior court in  
4 said city of Waterville, and is hereby authorized to raise  
5 by assessment or loan, and appropriate a sufficient sum of  
6 money for the purpose of providing said accommodation  
7 for the said court.

SECT. 6. There shall be allowed to the presiding justice  
2 of said superior court, and in addition to the salary of such  
3 justice, otherwise provided, and for the purpose of meeting  
4 the extra expenses of said justice, entailed by holding said

5 court at said city of Waterville, the sum of one hundred  
6 dollars, for each and every term of said court so held at said  
7 city of Waterville.

SECT. 7. An act entitled “ An Act to hold the February  
2 term of the superior court, Kennebec county, in the city  
3 of Waterville, approved February 8, 1889, is hereby  
4 repealed.
