STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-seven of chapter
seventy-one of the Revised Statutes, relating to
proof of notice of sale under license from probate
court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 27 of chapter 71 of the Re-
2 vised Statutes, is hereby amended by the addition
3 of the following words, after the word "recorded"
4 in the fifth line of said section, to wit: 'on such an
5 affidavit made afterwards by any person and filed
6 and recorded with such copy by permission of the
7 court upon satisfactory evidence that the notice

8 was given or ordered,' so that said section as
9 amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 27. The affidavit of any person licensed
11 as aforesaid or of any person employed by him
12 made within eighteen months after the sale and
13 filed in the probate office with one of the original
14 advertisements of the time, place and estate to be
15 sold, or with a copy of such advertisement and
16 recorded, or such an affidavit made afterwards by
17 any person and filed and recorded with such copy
18 by permission of the court upon satisfactory evi-
19 dence that the notice was given as ordered is
20 sufficient proof that such notice was given, and a
21 copy of such affidavit certified by the register, is
22 competent evidence thereof.
