STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter 376 of the Private
and Special Laws of 1877, relating to the Bryant's Pond
and Andover Telegraph Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter three hundred and
2 seventy-six of the private and special laws of eighteen
3 hundred and seventy-seven is hereby amended so as to
4 read as follows:

‘SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to
6 own, construct, maintain and operate a line or lines of
7 telegraph from the town of Andover, in the State of
8 Maine, through the towns of Rumford, Milton Plantation,
9 Bethel and Woodstock, to Bryant's Pond station, so
10 called, on the line of the Grand Trunk railroad, with the
11 right to extend the same to Hanover Village, by the most

12 favorable route. And said line may be constructed,
13 maintained and operated upon and along any public high-
14 way or bridge but in such manner as not to incommode
15 or endanger the customary public use thereof. And said
16 corporation may cut down any tree standing within the
17 limits of any highway, or in the line of its route, except
18 ornamental, shade or fruit trees, when necessary for the
19 erection, use or safety of its lines.'
