IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and seventy-
three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and
eighty-five, relating to Relief Associations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and seventy-
2 three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-five, entitled "An Act exempting Masonic,
4 Odd Fellows, and other relief associations, from the
5 operations of the statutes relating to life insurance,"
6 is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
