STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section 4 and Section 6 of Chapter 69
of the Public Laws of 1887, relating to the Commissioner
of Labor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section four, chapter sixty-nine of the Public Laws of
2 1887, is hereby amended by striking out the words "one
3 thousand," in the fifth line of said section, and substituting
4 the words 'fifteen hundred,' so that said section, as
5 amended, shall read as follows:

'SECT. 4. The commissioner herein named shall receive
7 an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars, and to aid in
8 carrying out the provisions of this act, said commissioner
9 is hereby authorized to employ such assistance and incur
10 such expense, not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars per
11 annum, as shall be necessary to carry out the provisions of
12 this act.'

Section six of said chapter is hereby amended by striking
14 out the word “ten,” in the sixth line of said section, and
15 substituting the word ‘six,’ so that said section, com-
16 mencing at the second word in the fifth line, shall read
17 as follows: ‘and said commissioner shall cause to be pub-
18 lished and circulated in this State, six thousand copies
19 annually of the results of his labors, as to the objects for
20 which commission is created.
