SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT

No. 136.

Insert in eighth line of section one, after the word
"date," the following:

‘Said superintendent shall biennially, as soon as
2 practicable after the adjournment of the legisla-
3 ture, compile and have printed in pamphlet form
4 three thousand copies of the amended school law
5 of the State, and distribute the same to the
6 municipal and school officers of the several towns;
7 and he shall furthermore prepare and issue thus
8 biennially such circulars of information and advice
9 to school officers relating to new school enact-
10 ments as he shall deem necessary for the intelligent
11 and effectual enforcement of such enactments.’
