STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend acts relating to a Municipal Court for the City of Lewiston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section sixteen of chapter six hun-
[2 dred and twenty-six of the Private and Special
3 Laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-
4 four are hereby amended by striking out said sec-
5 tion and inserting the following section in its stead:

‘All fines and penalties received by said clerk
7 except the fees allowed for taxing costs and record-
8 ing judgments in criminal matters, taking recog-
9 nizances of persons charged with crime, making
10 and recording libels of liquors seized and for
11 processes of commitment, shall be accounted for

12 and paid over to the County Treasurer, on the first
13 Tuesday of each month, and all fees allowed to
14 said judge by law in criminal cases and received
15 by said clerk, including the trial fee in civil cases,
16 shall be accounted for and paid over by him to the
17 Treasurer of the city of Lewiston monthly, and
18 all other fees received by him shall be paid to the
19 persons entitled by law to the same, as if received
20 by a trial justice. If in either case he neglects to
21 pay over the money as aforesaid he shall pay to
22 the county twenty-five per cent interest thereon
23 until paid. His accounts shall be audited by the
24 judge of said court and city solicitor of Lewiston
25 once in six months.'

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
