STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to chapter
eighteen of the Revised Statutes, concerning Ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. When proceedings have been had
2 by the county commissioner on a petition for laying
3 out, altering, grading or discontinuing a way in two
4 or more counties, an appeal may be taken in the
5 same manner as provided when the way is wholly
6 in one county.

SECT. 2. When an appeal is so taken it shall be
2 filed with the commissioners of, and subsequent
3 proceeding shall be had in, the county where pro-
4 ceedings originated and the commissioners with

5 whom such appeal is filed shall immediately give
6 notice of such appeal to the commissioners of all the
7 counties interested, and the clerk of courts shall
8 certify the final judgment of court to the commis-
9 sioners of all said counties.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
