STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Eye and Ear
Infirmary.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated
2 the sum of five thousand dollars to be paid to the
3 Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary for use of said
4 institution.

STATEMENT OF FACTS SUBMITTED.

The Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary is located in Portland, on Federal Street, opposite Lincoln Park. It is a public charitable institution established for the gratuitous treatment of the poor of the State for diseases of the eye and ear. It was incorporated according to the Statute Laws of Maine, February 15, 1886, and opened for the reception of patients April 22, 1886. Since that time the attendance has been over 25,000, over 3,000 patients have been registered and over 1,000 operations have been performed. The medical officers receive no pay for their services to the poor and the expenses have been met largely by voluntary contributions. The amount named in the Resolve is the sum appropriated at each session of the Legislature for the benefit of the institution since its establishment. For further information in regard to the work done at the institution reference is made to the annual Reports of the Officers.
