STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to confer certain powers upon the County
Commissioners of the county of Cumberland, and
the City Council of the city of Portland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the
2 county of Cumberland, and the city council of the
3 city of Portland are hereby authorized and empow-
4 ered by contract to release and convey each to the
5 other upon such terms as may be agreed, all or any
6 part of the respective interest and title of said
7 county and of said city, in the property at the
8 corner of Congress and Myrtle streets, in the city
9 of Portland, known as the city hall and court

10 house, and said property shall thereafter be held in
11 severalty, as may be agreed upon between said
12 county and said city, the interest of each to be
13 free and discharged of all interest or title in the
14 other.

SECT. 2. The county commissioners of said
2 county are hereby authorized and empowered to
3 represent and act for said county in all things that
4 may be done under the provisions of section one.

SECT. 3. Said commissioners of said county of
2 Cumberland and said city of Portland are each
3 hereby respectively authorized and empowered to
4 issue bonds to such an amount as may be necessary
5 to provide the funds required for the purposes
6 aforesaid, not, however, to exceed the constitutional
7 limitation.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
