STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-seven, of chapter
sixty-three of the Revised Statutes, relating to
Printed Blanks for Courts of Probate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section thirty-seven of chapter sixty-
2 three of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended
3 so that said section shall read as follows :

'Section 37. Each county shall provide all neces-
5 sary printed blanks and record books for its pro-
6 bate courts, and courts of insolvency, and said
7 record books may be printed to correspond with the
8 printed blanks, and whenever the judge of probate
9 deems it necessary or needful, he may cause said

10 blanks, or any of them, to be revised by some
11 suitable and competent person, and the cost and
12 expense of such revision shall be paid by the
13 county.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
