STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-seven, of chapter sixty-three of the Revised Statutes, relating to Printed Blanks for Courts of Probate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-seven of chapter sixty-2 three of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended 3 so that said section shall read as follows:

'Section 37. Each county shall provide all neces-

- 5 sary printed blanks and record books for its pro-
- 6 bate courts, and courts of insolvency, and said
- 7 record books may be printed to correspond with the
- 8 printed blanks, and whenever the judge of probate
- 9 deems it necessary or needful, he may cause said

- 10 blanks, or any of them, to be revised by some
- 11 suitable and competent person, and the cost and
- 12 expense of such revision shall be paid by the
- 13 county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
