AN ACT to annex Ragged Island in Casco Bay to
the County of Cumberland and the town of Harps-
well.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Ragged Island, in Casco Bay, is
2 hereby made and declared to be part of the
3 county of Cumberland, and of the town of Harps-
4 well therein.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
