IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

---

AN ACT to make the first Monday in September of  
each year a Labor Holiday.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The first Monday of September in  
2 each year, being the day celebrated and known as  
3 Labor's Holiday, is hereby made a legal public holi-  
4 day, to all intents and purposes, in the same manner  
5 as Thanksgiving, Fast and Christmas days, the  
6 twenty-second day of February, the thirtieth day of  
7 May, and the fourth day of July, are now by law  
8 made public holidays.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
