

RESOLVE in favor of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That five per cent of the shore rentals

- 2 of the Penobscot tribe of Indians for the year
- 3 eighteen hundred and ninety, be taken and expended
- 4 for municipal purposes, and that ten per cent be
- 5 taken for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one
- 6 for the same purpose, and that the same be expended
- 7 in said years eighteen hundred and ninety and
- 8 eighteen hundred and ninety-one under the direction
- 9 of the Indian Agent and resident priest.
