3 Home of Bangor for the year eighteen hundred and  
4 ninety-one, and the same amount for the year  
5 eighteen hundred and ninety-two.



BANGOR, January 6, 1891.

*To the Honorable Governor, Senate and House of Representatives of Maine:*

The undersigned would respectfully represent, that the Bangor Children's Home have more than fifty children under their charge from various towns in the eastern part of our State, some of them children of soldiers. Our income is not sufficient for their support, therefore we would ask from you one thousand this year and the same amount for next year, the same as has been granted to us, the past twenty years or more.
