STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the East Bluchill Telephone Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Henry A. Wallace, A. J. Grindle and W.

- 2 H. Wallace, their associates, successors and assigns are
- 3 hereby created a body politic, by the name of the East
- 4 Bluehill Telephone Company, with all the powers, rights
- 5 and privileges, and subject to all the duties and obliga-
- 6 tions granted and prescribed by the general laws of this
- 7 State relating to corporations. Said corporation shall
- 8 have the right to locate, construct, maintain and operate
- 9 a telephone line from the village of Bluehill to the village
- 10 of East Bluehill and from thence to some point in the 11 town of Surry.

- SECT. 2. Said company shall have the right, within the 2 limits aforesaid, to locate, construct and maintain its line 3 upon and along any public way, bridge or private lands, 4 but in such manner as not to incommode or endanger to 5 customary use of such way or bridge, with the right to 6 cut down down trees, remove obstacles when necessary 7 within the limits aforesaid, except ornamental, fruit or shade 8 trees, and with the power to establish and collect tolls on 9 said line.
- SECT. 3. If the land of any individual or corporation is 2 taken under this act and the parties cannot agree on the 3 damages occasioned thereby, they shall be estimated, 4 secured and paid as for land taken for highways.
- SECT. 4. Said corporation is hereby authorized to con2 nect its line or lines with those of any other company or
 3 to sell or lease its line either before or after computation to
 4 any other telephone or telegraph company, upon such
 5 terms as may be mutually agreed upon, which sale or lease
 6 shall be binding upon the parties, or to purchase or lease
 7 any other line or lines of telephone or telegraph, upon such
 8 terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.
 - SECT. 5. The amount of the capital stock shall be 2 fixed by vote of the corporation, but not to exceed the 3 amount that may from time to time be considered to be 4 necessary for the purposes herein specified, but not exceeding six thousand dollars, and said corporation may 6 purchase, hold, sell and convey real estate and personal 7 property necessary for the purposes contemplated in this 8 charter.
 - SECT. 6. Any one of the corporators named in this act 2 may call the first meeting of this company by mailing a

- 3 written notice to each of the other corporators, seven days
- 4 at least, before the day of meeting, naming the time,
- 5 place and purposes of such meeting; and at such meeting
- 6 a president, secretaray, treasurer and directors may be
- 7 chosen, by-laws adopted and any corporate business
- 8 transacted.

SECT. 7. This act shall take effect when approved.
