STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the County Attorney
of the County of Hancock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. On and after the first day of Jan-
2 uary in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
3 hundred and ninety-one, the salary of the county
4 attorney of Hancock county shall be four hundred
5 (\$400) dollars per annum, instead of the sum now
6 established by law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when
2 approved.
