STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize Bangor Street Railway to
extend its system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Bangor Street Railway is hereby
2 authorized to lay and maintain its rails, set poles,
3 and place wires, and operate its cars upon the
4 streets within the towns of Hampden, Orono, Old
5 Town and Veazie, or any of said towns, the license
6 of the municipal officers of such town or towns to
7 occupy such streets for such purposes having been
8 first obtained.

SECT. 2. Said Bangor Street Railway may issue
2 additional stock, and its bonds secured by a mort-
3 gage or mortgages of such additional track, equip-
4 ment, poles, wires, and other additional property as
5 may be necessary.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when
2 approved.
