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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

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AN ACT to amend the Charter of the City of  
Waterville, abolishing the Common Council.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of  
Waterville is hereby abolished and the mayor and  
board of aldermen shall constitute the city council.

SECT. 2. The annual election for municipal  
officers shall take place on the third Monday of  
March in each year.

SECT. 3. The city council shall annually on or  
before the first day of March cause to be published

3 and distributed for the information of the inhabit-  
4 ants of said city a full and particular account of all  
5 receipts and disbursements for the year ending the  
6 last day of January next preceding accompanied by  
7 a complete schedule of the city property and the  
8 city's indebtedness.

SECT. 4. All officers of the police and health  
2 departments shall be chosen as now provided by  
3 said charter and their terms of office shall expire on  
4 the fourth Monday of March following, but the  
5 mayor may suspend or remove any of said officers  
6 at any time for good cause.

SECT. 5. All other subordinate officers except  
2 as otherwise specially provided shall be elected by  
3 the city council annually on the fourth Monday of  
4 March, or as soon thereafter as may be, and their  
5 terms of office shall expire on the fourth Monday  
6 of March following. All vacancies may be filled  
7 by the city council at any regular meeting thereof.

SECT. 6. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 7. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
